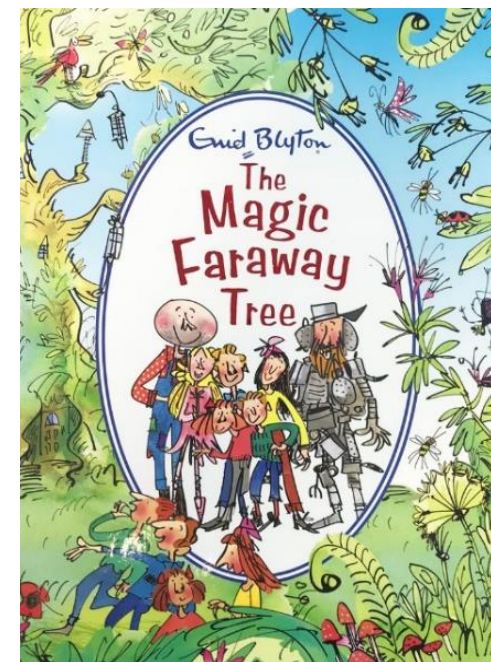
English





Art
