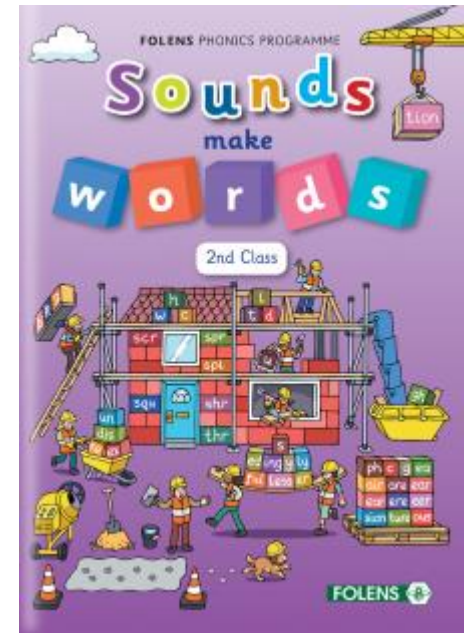
Seesaw
